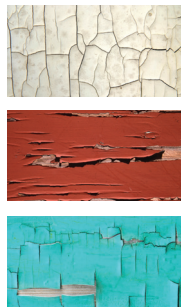

PAINTERS & CONTRACTORS MUST BE EPA CERTIFIED

EPA's Renovation, Repair and Painting Final Rule (40 CRF 745) DEADLINE IS **APRIL 22, 2010**

General Info

- **Violation of EPA regulation may result in fines up to \$32,500 and / or imprisonment**
- Renovation firms must be certified by the EPA
- Renovation firms must have 1 or more certified renovators
- EPA rule 40 CRF 745 applies to renovation of residential homes, apartments, child care facilities and schools built before 1978
- EPA certification is valid for 5 years

EPA certified renovator courses are hosted by California Paints. EPA certified renovator training is provided by Institute for Environmental Education (IEE). IEE is fully accredited by the US EPA to conduct training for the Renovation, Repair and Painting Final Rule (40 CRF 745). California Paints is not affiliated with the EPA or IEE.
